General Rules & Regulations

All students, teachers and workers of the *Institute of Islamic Sciences* are required to:

- Observe Islamic Shari`ah and adopt Islamic manners and morals in their everyday life;
- Pray their five times daily salah with congregation (*jama'ah*);
- Be punctual in their study and work;
- Have respect for their teachers, fellow students, books, co-workers, and their place of study and work;
- Take care of the *Institute's* property and things and not misuse them in any way;
- Not indulge in any kind of vain talk, political, confrontational, sectarian, or disruptive discussions;
- Be clean and keep their study, living and working environment clean, and wear Islamic dress/uniform during their stay in the *Institute* premises;
- During the study hours, No outsiders will be allowed except for genuine reason;
- Smoking or use of any kind of addictive drugs and alcoholic drinks are strictly forbidden for all students, teachers and workers of the *Institute*.
